Do it yourself?

Some challenges in requiring socially responsible manufacturing in procurement of IT

1. Competence

Enough competence exist to formulate criteria in a clear way and handle questions and consequences?

2. Relations

Enough relations exist with factories and brands to negotiate and achieve improvements?

3. Follow up of set criteria

Enough time and money exist to follow up all criteria every year during the contract?

4. Corrective action plan

Will you demand corrective actions and proof of the implementation of these?

5. Consequences

Will you have consequence if corrective actions are not implemented on time?



Sign a legally binding license agreement with TCO Development



Have a serious code of conduct and ensure it is communicated and implemented in the supply chain.



Conduct audits on each final assembly factory at least once every three years.

Send one third party audit report to TCO Development for review every year.

Handle non-conformities in the whole supply chain in a responsible way according to corrective action plans.

Appoint a Senior Management Representative who ensure implementation of the code of conduct and report this to TCO Development annually.



Annually report proactive work to minimize risk of non conformities against the code of conduct



Have a public conflict mineral policy.



Have a management system for conflict minerals according to OECD guideline or be part of an in region initiative minimizing the negative impact of conflict minerals.
